Note: An appositive phrase is just a group of words with no verbal—it just renames a noun or pronoun. Prepositional Phrase This is a phrase that always begins with a preposition and usually ends with a noun or pronoun (called the object of the preposition). Example: One of the doors is locked, and I need the key to open it.
