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The beginning of a fable introduces the characters and setting (exposition), the middle provides a brief story (rising action and climax), and the end wraps it up with a lesson (resolution). Fables are short pieces of prose.

Listening to stories and telling one's own stories are opportunities for practising all parts of oral language, including speech, vocabulary and grammar. It is also important for the development of inferencing skills, which become important when children begin to read, and practice reading comprehension (Kleeck, 2008).
