Observation, Documentation, and Reflection | Early ...

A preschool observation form is a document that preschool teachers use for assessing and evaluating a child enrolled in a preschool institution. This document commonly contains three sections that are intended for the general information of the child, the varying skills as well as activities that the child took, and the comments of the observer about the child's observation results.

Documentation may lead to a good plan, sometimes referred to a behavior plan (there is a sheet for that in the Behavior Observation Log printable here), that lays out the steps needed to help the child overcome this behavior. At times documentation helps to make clear that the challenges are too great for your classroom.
