Facial Reconstruction Skin cancers of the facial tissue are typically not life threatening, but certainly can be locally destructive. The most common skin cancers are basal cell cancer and squamous cell cancer. When these cancers are removed, the resultant tissue defect is often unsightly and needs plastic surgery repair.
