Front lighting from slots in the auditorium ceiling serviced by catwalks is highly desirable. Ellipsoidal spotlights are used to light the acting area.

In the basement of the Auditorium, there’s a large crack on the concrete floor that runs parallel to the exterior wall. While the whole building has settled, this is where it’s obvious that the heavier exterior stone walls have sunk almost a foot more than the interior structure, which was made from a lighter iron and steel skeleton.
